

Report of State Handicapper to 2011 AGM

Over the last 12 months or so the Handicapping system arrangements have worked smoothly.

The introduction of immediate handicap changes in Association Croquet (rather than waiting until the end of an event) was uneventful. This brought the Association system into line with the Golf Croquet system and has been easily understood.

I would like to thank

- First and foremost, Elaine Roomes, who quickly and efficiently updates handicap information on the website when I advise her of changes
- Those clubs that regularly keep me informed of handicap changes.

Over the next few weeks I would ask all clubs to look at the handicap list which appears on the website and to advise me of any changes required. I suspect that we list some people who are no longer club members and that we may not have recorded the names and handicaps of newer members. I can provide ID numbers for new members.

Most importantly clubs should now look at the handicaps of all members and make manual adjustments to those non competition playing members if their current handicaps are no longer realistic. Any changes should be advised to me. This applies equally to Association and Golf Croquet handicaps.
